

RDA Safeguarding Training for Volunteers



Safeguarding is all about protecting children and vulnerable adults from harm. To help you know what to look out for, the RDA has created a free short online course that they'd like all volunteers over 16 to do. To access it you'll need an account - which is easy to set up. 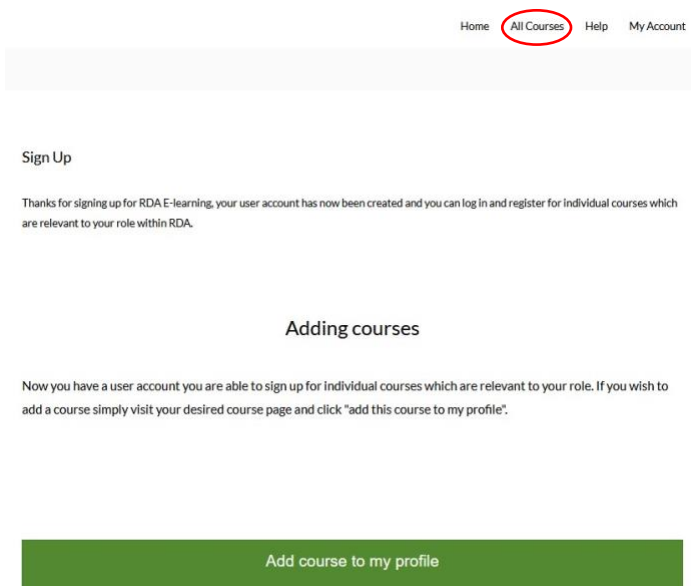

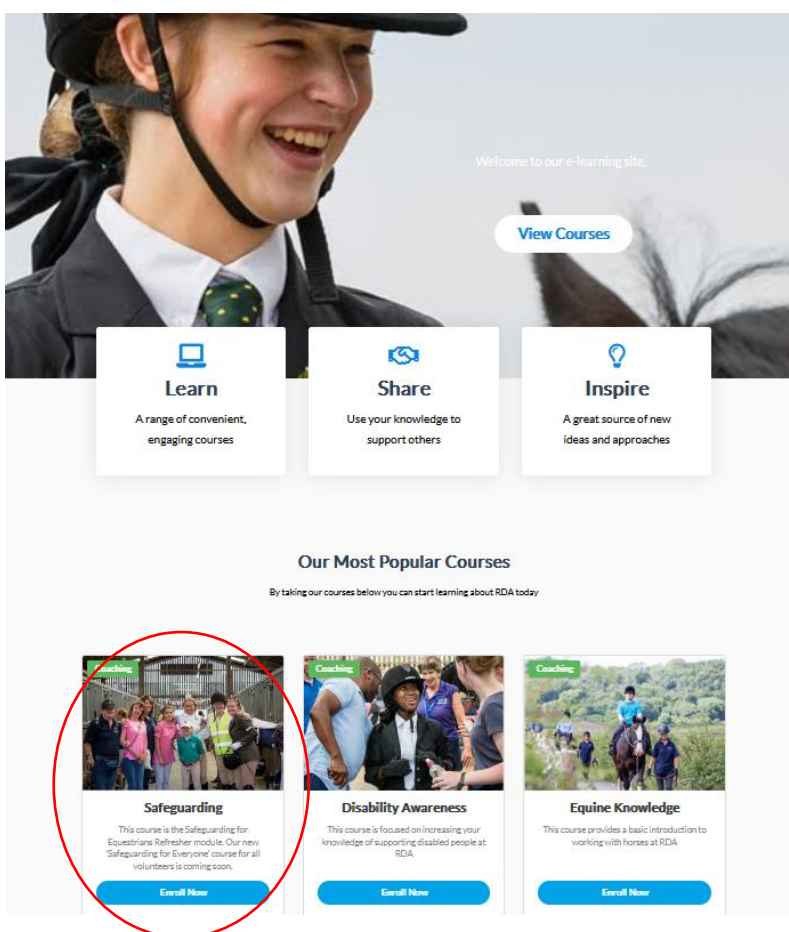
